# Climate Corporate Data Accountability Act



## Who must comply?

✓ U.S. companies with over \$1B in revenue
 ✓ Operating in California, regardless of HQ
 ✓ Includes public & private companies

### What's required?

✓ Publicly disclose Scope
 1, 2, and 3 GHG emissions
 ✓ Must use the GHG
 Protocol
 ✓ Data must be digitally

submitted and independently verified 
✓ Subject to civil penalties for non-compliance

#### Key deadlines

July 1, 2025 CARB finalizes rules 2026

Scope 1 & 2 reporting begins

2027

Scope 3 reporting begins **2030** 

Must meet "reasonable assurance" verification
